

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS COMMUNITY JUSTICE REINVESTMENT GRANTS 2022

Overview: Overview: The Minnesota 2016 legislature established the Community Justice Reinvestment Account. This stems from sentencing guidelines revisions which are intended to result in correctional cost savings to the state. These savings are intended to be transferred from the general fund to this account to support services that will reduce further involvement in the criminal justice system. In fiscal year 2017 this account was established with an appropriation of \$488,000 from the special revenue fund. As stated in the legislation, these funds are to support:

- Chemical dependency and mental health treatment programs,
- Programs that improve supervision,
- Pretrial and precharge supervision programs,
- Programs to reduce recidivism of controlled substances offenders on probation or supervised release or participating in drug courts,
