The Bylaws of the Statewide Emergency Communications Board prescribes the membership of its Interoperable Data Committee, and *membership is comprised of one primary and one alternate from each of the following:*

- *Minnesota Department of Public Safety;*
- *Office of Enterprise Technology (MN.IT Services);*
- *Minnesota Department of Transportation;*
- *Minnesota Department of Natural Resources;*
- *Minnesota State Patrol;*
- *League of Minnesota Cities;*
- *Association of Minnesota Counties;*
- *Minnesota Sheriffs’ Association;*
- *Minnesota Chiefs of Police Association;*
- *Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Association;*
- *Minnesota Ambulance Association;*
- *Minnesota Indian Affairs Council or Tribal Government;*
- *and each regional emergency communications or emergency services board or equivalent.*

Membership may also include non-voting seats representing non-government and private industry partners at the discretion of the committee.

Effective September 27, 2018, the Statewide Emergency Communication Board approved the addition of a Member-at-Large.
