NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION - AMENDED LIQUOR LICENSE SUSPENSION

Emergency Networks

Pursuant to Governor Walz's Executive Order 20-99 Implementing a Four Week Dial Back on Certain Activities Communication to Slow the Spread of COVID-19 (EO-99), all restaurants and bars are prohibited from selling alcohol for onpremises consumption from Friday, November 20, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. through Friday, December 18, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.¹

Homeland Security and **Emergency** Management

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety's Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement (AGED) may take civil action in the form of a fine, license suspension, or license revocation for any violation of statute, rule or ordinance related to alcoholic beverages. Minn. Stat. § 340A.415.

Minnesota State | AGED was notified that Boardwalk Bar & Grill (BBG) failed to comply with a Cease and Desist Order issued by the Minnesota Department of Health on December 10, 2020. That order was based upon BBG's opening for onpremises consumption of food and alcoholic beverages on December 9. This constituted BBG's first violation. On December 11, the Polk County District Court granted the Minnesota Attorney General's request for a Temporary Communications Restraining Order, which prevented BBG from taking any further action in violation of EO-99. BBG did not comply with the Court's Order.

Office of Justice **Programs**

On December 13, you - as the owner of BBG - were served with a Notice of Agency Action informing you that, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 340A.415, the liquor license #26788 issued to the Boardwalk Bar & Grill, LLC was suspended, effective immediately, for a period 60-days.

This Notice of Agency Action-Amended clarifies that the suspension of license #26788 is not effective until you have had the opportunity for a hearing before the Office of Administrative Hearings. Pursuant to the Minnesota Administrative Procedures Act², AGED will schedule this hearing at the earliest possible date. You will receive further instructions from the Office of Administrative Hearings.
