NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION 60-DAY LIQUOR LICENSE SUSPENSION

Pursuant to Governor Walz's Executive Order 20-99 *Implementing a Four Week Dial Back on Certain Activities to Slow the Spread of COVID-19* (EO-99), all restaurants and bars are prohibited from selling alcohol for on-premises consumption from Friday, November 20, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. through Friday, December 18, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety's Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement (AGED) may take civil action in the form of a fine, license suspension or license revocation for any violation of Statute, Rule or Ordinance related to alcoholic beverages. Minn. Stat. § 340A.415.

AGED has documented evidence provided by the Princeton Police Department, incident report #20004768, that Neighbor's on Rum opened in violation of EO-99 on December 16, 2020.

As a result of these actions, AGED intends to suspend liquor license # 39684 issued to Neighbor's on the Rum for a period 60-days. Pursuant to the Minnesota Administrative Procedures Act², this suspension is not effective until you have had the opportunity for a hearing before the Office of Administrative Hearings. AGED will schedule this hearing at the earliest possible date. You will receive further instructions from the Office of Administrative Hearings.
