

FIRST AMENDMENT TO
TECHNICAL STANDARDS IN
TRIBAL-STATE COMPACT FOR CONTROL OF
CLASS III BLACKJACK
ON THE
FOND DU LAC BAND OF LAKE SUPERIOR CHIPPEWA
RESERVATION IN MINNESOTA

Pursuant to Section 7 of the Tribal-State Compact for Control of Class III Blackjack on the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Reservation in Minnesota, the State of Minnesota, by and through its Commissioner of Public Safety, and the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa, agree as follows:

1. Section 4.5(6)(K) is deleted and replaced with the following language:


"At any time when all players leave the table and prior to play resuming, all cards in the shoe and discarded shall be spread out face upwards on the table for visual inspection by the first player or players to arrive at the table. Upon request by the first player or players, the cards shall be spread out in horizontal fan shaped columns by deck according to suit and in sequence."
