

## 2012 Crímínal Justice Information Users Conference

## **Exhibitor Information**

The Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) invites you to participate as an exhibitor in its Criminal Justice Information Users Conference on September 11-12 at the River's Edge Convention Center in St. Cloud, Minnesota.

New this year, the BCA is adding two tracks specifically for investigators and patrol personnel. Participants also include law enforcement, court personnel, prosecutors, public defenders, corrections, human services and records staff from all areas of criminal justice. This year's conference will once again feature a stamp card which encourages attendees to visit each vendor booth.

The cost of exhibitor space is \$450.00 for an 8-foot table-top or backdrop display. Registration after July 13 is \$500.00. The non-profit vendor fee is \$100.00. Minnesota criminal justice agency personnel who purchase booth space and wish to

attend conference sessions must also register separately as conference attendees. The exhibitor registration fee includes:

- Lunch on Tuesday & Wednesday •
- Registration for two booth staff (additional staff will be charged \$50/person)
