Letter must identify you as currently appointed by the respective government to serve in Minnesota. They will complete this form electronically Only print this application if you need to submit by mail

Honorary Consul plates are available to members of Minnesota Consular Corps.

The plates convey no special functions, no reduction of registration taxes, or "diplomatic immunity".

The plates are produced with the 3 letter Olympic Code of the country the applicant represents. Example: Belgium = BEL 1
