What is the purpose of supplying the requested information?

The Department of Public Safety ("DPS") collects the information on this form for identification purposes, for consideration for a reduced fee in the Minnesota Ignition Interlock Program and as outlined in Minn. Stat. § 171.306(2)(b)(1) and the Minnesota Ignition interlock Program Guidelines.

Am I required to provide the requested information?

You are not legally required to complete this form.

What will happen if I do not provide the requested information?

You can refuse; however, DPS may consider your application incomplete, and will be unable to process your request for the reduced fee.

Who will have access to the requested information?

DPS may disclose personal information when it relates to the operation or use of a vehicle or to public safety. The use of personal information relates to public safety if it concerns the physical safety or security of drivers, vehicles, pedestrians or property. The personal information you provide for consideration for a reduced fee in the Ignition Interlock Device Program is classified by 18 U.S.C. § 2721 and Minn. Stat. § 171.12, and is subject to the disclosure in accordance with these laws.

I verify the information on this document is truthful and accurate. I understand that providing any false information will prohibit me from receiving the reduced fee and require that I pay the regular fees for the remainder of my time in the ignition interlock device program.
