YOUR COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE WILL EXPIRE ON FEBRUARY 28, 2021

Dear [First Last Name]:

The expiration date of your driver's license or identification card was extended during the COVID-19 emergency order (Chapter 71, 2020 Minnesota Session Law, and Regular Session).

Commercial driver's licenses (CDL) are regulated by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA). FMCSA's license expiration extensions are set to expire February 28, 2021. If your medical certificate expired on or after September 1, 2020 you will need to provide your updated medical certificate and self-certification form to remain certified. Failure to update your medical certificate will result in your CDL being downgraded.

Your commercial driver's license will **expire on February 28, 2021**. The cost to renew is <\$xx.xx>.

- **Renew Online.** You can renew your commercial license online if you are not changing your name, address or license number. Visit the DPS-DVS website drive.mn.gov to renew online.
- **Renew In Person.** To obtain a REAL ID, enhanced driver's license or identification, or to change your name, address or license number, you will need to visit a licensing office.

Please note that many offices require an appointment. Visit dvs.dps.mn.gov then click on "locations" to find an office near you and for information about appointments.

For faster service, please pre-apply online at drive.mn.gov before visiting a licensing office. Pre-applying saves time at the counter and ensures you have the required documents to complete the application at your local office.

Some DPS-DVS regional exam stations will be open on Saturdays starting Feb. 20 through March 27 to process applications. For locations and hours visit drive.mn.gov and click on "news" and select COVID-19 FAQs.

- If you have a valid, unexpired U.S. passport you do not need a REAL ID. You may use your unexpired U.S. passport to access federal facilities or board a domestic aircraft. For help deciding which credential is right for you or for more information visit drive.mn.gov.
