Eligibility Requirements

- Be at least 18 years old and eligible for a class D driver's license or instruction permit
- Own/drive a vehicle with valid insurance; must be a Class D type vehicle, no motorcycles or mopeds
- Have no outstanding withdrawals which would prohibit the issuance of a limited license or full license (either in Minnesota or in any other state)
- If driving privilege was revoked prior to age 18, must not be subject to Vanessa's Law
