

CANCELED AND DENIED AS INIMICAL TO PUBLIC SAFETY



Eligibility Requirements

- Be at least 18 years old and eligible for a class D driver's license or instruction permit.
- Own/drive a vehicle with valid insurance.
- Have no outstanding withdrawals.
- If driving privilege revoked prior to age 18, must not be subject to Vanessa's Law.

TO ENROLL IN THE IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE PROGRAM, COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING STEPS	
I have reviewed and agree to abide by the Ignition Interlock Program Guidelines.	
I have reviewed the legislative changes made to the Ignition Interlock Program that are not contained in the program guidelines.	
Pay the \$680 reinstatement fee (only required if revoked in addition to the cancellation and denial).	
Apply for a new Class D driver's license (MN residents only).	
Sign and date the Ignition Interlock Participation Agreement.	
Submit a chemical use assessment and comply with the recommendations if any. Fax to (651) 797-1738.	
Sign and date the Last Use Statement.	
Submit an Insurance Identification Card. A Certificate of Insurance will be required if your driving record shows a history of an insurance conviction.	

SUBMIT APPLICATION PAPERWORK. AN INTERVIEW WITH A DRIVER EVALUATOR IS NOT REQUIRED.
