

MINNESOTA DRIVER'S LICENSE AND ID OPTIONS

WHAT DO I NEED TO BOARD A PLANE NOW?

Minnesotans can use their standard driver's license or ID card to board a domestic flight **until Oct. 1, 2021**. On and after that date, a REAL ID, enhanced driver's license or ID, passport or passport card will be required for those wanting to board domestic flights or enter federal facilities. Consider applying for a REAL ID now or when you renew your license or ID card **prior to Oct. 1, 2021**.

STANDARD DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID CARD

- Acceptable for domestic air travel and to access federal facilities now until Oct. 1, 2021.
- Starting Oct. 1, 2021, these won't be acceptable forms of identification for domestic air travel or federal use.
- They will remain valid for identification purposes and lawful driving privileges.

ENHANCED DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID CARD

- Can be used for domestic air travel and to access federal facilities now.
- Will continue to be acceptable forms of identification for federal purposes even after Oct. 1, 2021.
- Can be used as U.S. border crossing documents.
- Only issued to U.S. citizens.
- Valid for identification purposes.
- Valid for lawful driving privileges.
- An EDL/EID costs \$15 in addition to the standard license or ID card fee.

REAL ID COMPLIANT DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ID CARD

- Minnesotans can apply for a REAL ID-compliant card now.
- REAL ID driver's licenses or ID cards can be used for domestic air travel and to access federal facilities such as military bases and nuclear power plants.
- Issued to both U.S. and non-U.S. citizens.
- Cannot be used as border crossing documents.
- Valid for identification purposes.
- Valid for lawful driving privileges.
- A REAL ID costs the same as a standard license or ID card.
