

# Sample EOC Activation Levels

This matrix describes the level of EOC activation at any time. Agencies/departments may use it as a guide to develop standard operating procedures/guidelines.

<b>Level IV Continuous monitoring</b>	<b>Level IV Monitoring:</b> Operations Section (EM) in coordination with dispatch (PSAP) maintains countywide situational awareness.	<i>Operations Section</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continuously monitor weather and other current and significant events.</li> <li>• Work in cooperation with emergency management partners.</li> <li>• Issue information products to maintain situational awareness and a common operating picture.</li> </ul>
<b>Level III EOC activation with command and general staff</b>	<b>Level III Partial Activation:</b> Activates appropriate agencies or ICS sections to closely monitor a developing situation or incident with limited impact. Actions may include preparing to provide or providing necessary assistance.	<i>Incident Manager (IM)</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Responsible for EOC management</li> </ul> <i>Operations Chief</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinate agencies</li> <li>• Field situational awareness</li> </ul> <i>Planning Chief</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Situation Reports</li> <li>• Incident Action Plans (IAP)</li> </ul>
<b>Level II EOC activation with command and general staff, and select agencies</b>	<b>Level II Full Activation:</b> Responds to an actual event having significant impacts over large geographical areas. The county board directs agencies/departments to provide assistance under the local state of emergency assigning emergency responsibilities to agencies.	<i>IM</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EOC Management</li> </ul> <i>Operations Chief</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinate agencies</li> <li>• Field situation awareness</li> </ul> <i>Planning Chief</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Situation Reports</li> <li>• Incident Action Plans (IAP)</li> </ul> <i>Logistics Chief</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Supplies</li> <li>• Resource management</li> </ul> <i>Select agencies/departments, as required for the incident or event.</i>
<b>Level I Full EOC activation with state support</b>	<b>Level I Full Activation with State Support:</b> Initiated by a local state of emergency declaration and includes full state support.	<i>All staffing noted for Level II, plus full complement of supporting agencies.</i>
