Agency Summary

To date, a total of 15 counties have been identified with HPAI positive premises. The counties are: Cottonwood, Kandiyohi, Lac Qui Parle, Le Sueur, Lyon, Meeker, Nobles, Otter Tail, Pope, Redwood, Roseau, Stearns, Swift, Wadena, Watonwan.

HSEM Staff have been actively collaborating with partner agencies and county emergency management staff.

- The SEOC continues to be at Activation Level III - Partial Activation in response to the HPAI outbreak.
- Operations, Planning and Logistics attended the SEOC Chiefs Briefing in the SEOC.
- The Operations and Preparedness Branch Directors attended the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) situational briefing.
- Operations, Planning, and Logistics Staff monitored the MDA Briefing conference call.
- Operations, Planning and Logistics Staff held the daily state agency conference call.
- Logistics Section staff are providing resource assistance to county Emergency Managers.
- DisasterLAN continues to be updated frequently with the latest news, fact sheets and other information for situational awareness.

MN Department of Health

Agency Summary

Monitoring Data as of 4/20/2015

- In total, 101 people were involved in care of the flocks, and were interviewed and evaluated.
- We are currently monitoring poultry personnel for development of an eye infection or respiratory symptoms: cough, fever, sore throat, runny nose.
- MDH follow-up and monitoring for 10 days has been completed for 40 people associated with 11 flocks.
- We have sampled 10 people with cold symptoms, but have not identified any infections with this.

- Minnesota National Guard continues to monitor the situation.
- No requests for assistance have been requested at this time.

MN Department of Natural Resources

Agency Summary

- DNR is asking the public to send the agency reports of sick or dead waterfowl, wild turkeys or birds of prey. The agency will test any of suspect birds for the virus.
