Operations Section Chief

Agency Summary

As of June 9th, a total of 39 counties have been impacted.

HSEM/SEOC Staff have been actively collaborating with partner agencies and county emergency management staff.

- The SEOC is at "*Activation Level III - Partial Activation*" in response to the HPAI outbreak.
- SEOC Staff monitored the daily MDA Briefing conference calls.
- DisasterLAN continues to be updated frequently with the latest news, fact sheets and other information for situational awareness.

MN Department of Agriculture

Agency Summary

The MN Department of Agriculture (MDA) is operating under a Unified Command with the MN Board of Animal Health and the USDA-APHIS-Veterinary Services. The MDA is conducting these activities as part of the response to the HPAI incident:

- Represent the State of Minnesota on the Unified Command
- Manage the state-federal fiscal response and state cooperative agreement
- Order, organize, deploy, and track equipment, supplies, and human resources
- Build daily Incident Action Reports, lead, and participate in daily planning activities
- Manage data generated by the incident and lead entry into the EMRS database
- Provide maps and GIS resources relevant to the incident
- Participate in environmental sampling on infected premises
- Direct and record euthanasia activities on infected premises
- Act as liaison between incident personnel and the poultry industry
- Contribute to the public information officer pool to manage communications
- Set overall safety objectives

MN Department of Commerce

Agency Summary

- Commerce continues to monitor the incident through DLAN and SEOC State Agency Briefings.

- MDE continues to monitor the incident through DLAN and call in briefings.

MN Department of Health

Agency Summary

Following are the MDH Behavioral Health Medical Reserve Corps Response Actions:

- 4/28/2015 - Sent 150 of the Self-Care Flip books and biodots to the Wilmar EOC.
- 5/1/2015 - We provided handouts (*Responder self-care*, *Psychological First Aid (PFA)*, *When Something Terrible Happens*, *Talking to Children*, *Dealing with Financial Stress*, and the *Disaster Distress Helpline* card and brochure) to Stearns and Kandiyohi Counties and offered assistance to Meeker.
- 5/6/2015 - Provided the Wilmar EOC with 500 laminated copies of the *Disaster Distress Helpline* card.
- 5/14/2015 - Deployed Behavioral Health Medical Response Corps (MRC) volunteers to Stearns County to provide two (2) Psychological First Aid trainings for Stearns County staff.
- 5/20/2015 – Provided 50 of the Self-Care flip books and biodots to the Freeman building EOC.
- 6/2/2015 – Deployed Behavioral Health MRC volunteers to Stearns County to provide three (3) Just-in-Time Psychological First Aid trainings and to staff a booth and talk with community members on stress management. They provided stress management handouts, adult and youth PFA cards and stress balls.

MN Department of Natural Resources

Agency Summary

- DNR is asking the public to send them any agency reports of sick or dead waterfowl, wild turkeys or birds of prey. The agency will test any of suspect birds for the virus.
- To date, DNR has collected 81 total sick/dead wild bird samples. Test Results - HPAI Positive: 1 (Cooper's Hawk, Yellow Medicine County); Negative: 74; Pending: 6
- DNR has collected 3,138 waterfowl fecal samples from lands near infected flocks and from control sites (major waterfowl production areas without known infection). Test Results - HPAI Positive: 0; LPAI Positive: 100; Negative: 3038; Pending: 0
- Wild turkeys harvested near HPAI infected areas are being tested. To date, 84 hunter harvested wild turkey samples have been submitted for testing. Results - HPAI Positive: 0; Negative: 81; Pending: 3
- DNR is testing waterfowl that are live-captured and banded for exposure to HPAI. To date, 9 samples have been collected. All test results are negative.
