Current Situation

Background

Minnesota saw significant precipitation fall throughout portions the state during June and the first weeks of July. Beginning June 11, a high precipitation weather system crossed the state causing localized flooding due to stream, river and lake rises coupled with saturated soils. Koochiching and Rock counties began reporting flooding, but experienced little infrastructure damage early in the period.

On June 19, 2014, Governor Mark Dayton issued Governor's Executive Order 14-11, "Declaring a State of Peacetime Emergency in the State of Minnesota" in 35 Minnesota counties.

On July 9, 2014, Governor Dayton submitted a request for a Presidential Disaster Declaration to the White House.

On July 21, 2014, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency announced that federal disaster aid has been made available to the State of Minnesota to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the area affected by severe storms, straight-line winds, flooding, landslides, and mudslides during the period of June 11 to July 11, 2014. This is disaster DR-4182.

SEOC Governor's Authorized Representative

Agency Summary

- Today, HSEM sent a request to the Federal Coordinating Officer to add the following counties to DR-4182: Beltrami, Blue Earth, Brown, Carver, Dakota, Dodge, Faribault, Hennepin, Koochiching, La Qui Parle, Lake of the Woods, Le Sueur, Lyon, Marshall, Martin, McLeod, Nicollet, Ramsey, Redwood, Rice, Roseau, Scott, Sibley, Steele, Todd, Wadena, Waseca, Watonwan, Wright, Yellow Medicine and the tribal governments of the Red Lake Band of Chippewa and Prairie Island Indian Community.

Operations Section Chief

Agency Summary

- The next Recovery Phase Situation Report will be published the afternoon of Monday, August 4.
- Agencies should submit their reports for activities this week no later than Noon, August 4 for inclusion in the Weekly Recovery Phase Situation Report.
- The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) remains at Activation Level III: Partial Activation to support on-going Recovery activities. The incident officially began on June 11th, 2014.
- **Process for Recovery Resource Requests**
 - The MN Duty Officer will take calls from *County Emergency Managers (or their designee)* requesting resources for recovery efforts (651-649-5451 / 800-422-0798).
 - The request will be routed to the SEOC where a corresponding DisasterLAN call ticket can be entered, tracked and actions can be documented.
 - Coordination with the Public/Private Coordination and Action Team (P2CAT), or other appropriate entity, will be handled by SEOC Logistics.
 - Requesters can track request progress by using the DisasterLAN Ticket Manager and searching for the corresponding DLAN call ticket.
- The Operations Section continues maintaining situational awareness for SEOC partners and those involved in the recovery process.

MN Department of Corrections

Agency Summary

- On July 28, 2014 the Minnesota Department of Corrections assigned eight ICWC offenders and one staff person to rebuild a bridge destroyed during flooding in Eden Prairie, MN.

MN Department of Employment and Economic Development

Agency Summary

- Koochiching county has requested that DEED re-activate their business survey as that county continues to move through the assessment process. Businesses there have not had a chance to complete the survey.
