VIII. Indicator Lamps

A. Eight Lamp Indicator Malfunction

(10)A. There must be a red pilot lamp which must go on when the respective amber or red systems are activated. The pilot must either go out or flash at an altered rate in the event the system is not functioning normally.

B. Headlamp High Beam Indicator

(2) B. Means shall be provided to indicate to the driver when high beam headlamps are in operation.

C. Turn Signal Indicator

(5) C. Means shall be provided to indicate to the driver when the turn signals are in operation.

D. Four Way Flasher

(5) D. Means shall be provided to indicate to the driver when four-way flashers are in operation.

E. Strobe Lamp

(5) E. Means shall be provided to indicate to the driver when strobe lamp is in operation.

F. Strobe Lamp

(2) F. Means shall be provided to indicate to the driver when the wheel chair lift door is ajar.
