Inspection Report Form:

The inspection form was modified August 2008. The check boxes for lines 23 and 24 have been deleted. You may use the old form; leave check box 23 blank. **The new inspection form and 2nd page are available on our website.**

Manual:

The manual has been updated and may be downloaded from the website.

Provider List:

The provider list is available on our website and in your manual.

2011 Decal Order Form

The decal order form is on our website. **Decal transfers are not allowed.** A business has 2 options when an inspector is leaving: They may sell the decals to the resigning inspector or destroy the decals. All other forms are also available on our website.

Change of Address or Employment

Inspectors must inform the State Patrol immediately of a change of address or employment, by filling out a change of address or employment form. Failure to inform the State Patrol will result in suspension of the inspector's certification. (The form is in the manual or on our website.)

Recertification Classes

The Mandatory Inspection Program inspector certification is valid for 2 years from certification or recertification date. Inspectors must recertify before the expiration date to maintain an active status. If you do not recertify before the expiration of your certification, your certification will be canceled and you will not be able to perform inspections or order decals. You may reactivate your certification within six months following your expiration date by attending a recertification class. Recertification classes are offered at a variety of locations statewide. See our website for locations and contact information. If you do not reactivate with six months following the expiration of your certification, your certification will be revoked and you will have to attend a certification course to have your number reinstated.
