2021 Stats

Programs in Carver, Dakota, Goodhue, Le Sueur, Scott, Sibley and McLeod counties received \$6.9 million in total funding — Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and state — that helped provide services for 14,568 victims.

- Domestic violence – 6,058
- General crime – 5,124
- 3 emergency domestic violence shelters provided:
 - Shelter bed nights: 11,892 women and 14,427 children
- Sexual assault – 1,918
- Supervised visitation – 538
- Abused children – 79
