

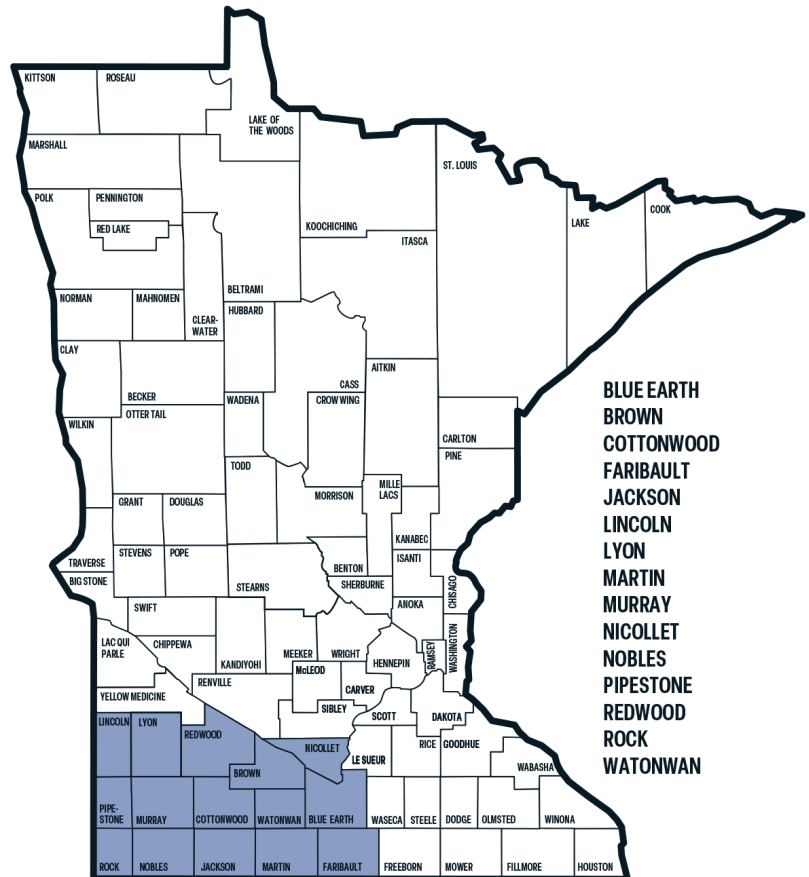

VOCA-Funded Programs and Services

2021 Stats

Programs in Blue Earth, Brown, Cottonwood, Faribault, Jackson, Lincoln, Lyon, Martin, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Pipestone, Redwood, Rock and Watonwan counties received \$4 million in total funding — Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and state — that helped provide services to 6,382 victims.

- Domestic violence victims – 2,706
- General crime victims – 2,690
- 1 emergency domestic violence shelter provided:
 - Shelter bed nights: 2,888 women and 3,057 children
- Sexual assault victims – 501
- Supervised visitation for children – 123
- Child advocacy center – 88
- Abused children – 116
