
## 2021 Stats

Programs in Becker, Benton, Clay, Douglas, Mille Lacs, Morrison, Otter Tail, Stearns, Todd and Wadena counties received \$7.4 million in total funding — Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and state — that helped provide services to 19,322 victims.

  - Shelter bed nights: 7,975 women and 8,785 children
