

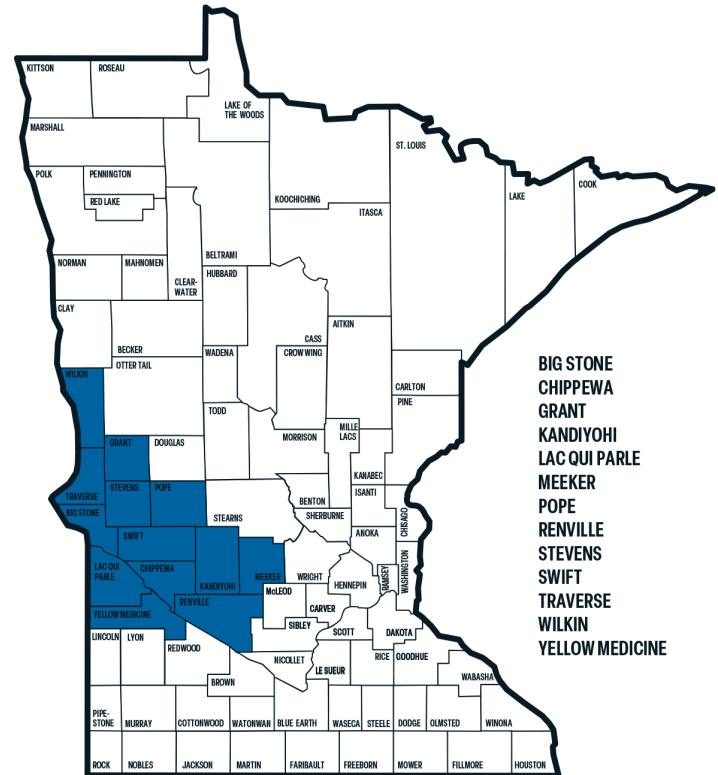

2021 Stats

Programs in Big Stone, Chippewa, Grant, Kandiyohi, Lac Qui Parle, Meeker, Pope, Renville, Stevens, Swift, Traverse, Wilkin and Yellow Medicine counties received \$4.1 million in total funding — Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and state — that helped provide services to 4,844 victims.

- Domestic violence victims – 1,717
- General crime victims – 2,071
- 1 emergency domestic violence shelter provided:
 - Shelter bed nights: 762 women and 886 children
- Sexual assault victims – 457
- Supervised visitation for children – 415
