

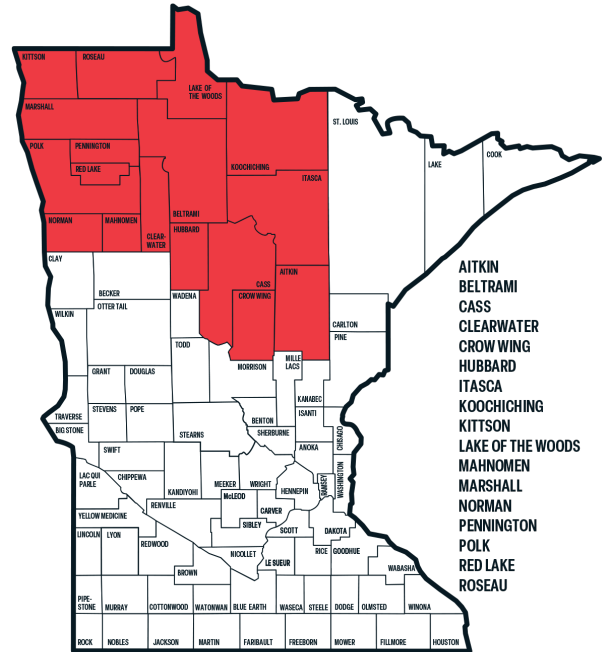

VOCA-Funded Programs and Services

2021 Stats

Programs in Aitkin, Beltrami, Cass Clearwater, Crow Wing, Hubbard, Itasca, Koochiching, Kittson, Lake of the Woods, Mahnommen, Marshall, Norman, Pennington, Polk, Red Lake and Roseau counties received \$7.8 million in total funding — Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and state — that helped provide services to 16,052 victims.

- Domestic violence victims – 4,612
- General crime victims – 5,533
- 5 emergency domestic violence shelters (including 2 tribal nation shelters) provided:
 - Shelter bed nights: 7,584 women and 8,510 children
- Sexual assault victims – 511
- Supervised visitation for children – 3,830
- Child advocacy center – 695
- Abused children – 418
