Sex Trafficking Investigation and Training Grants (2020)

Overview: The State of Minnesota has designated grant funds to increase the capacity of local law enforcement to conduct sex trafficking investigations. \$1.95 million for two-year grants with local, state and tribal governments to support sex trafficking investigations and training.

The grants are for,

- New or existing multijurisdictional entities to investigate sex trafficking cases;
- Training, case consultation and technical assistance to law enforcement agencies statewide;
- Capacity building through training attendance.
