YOUTH & COMMUNITY CRIME PREVENTION GRANTS 2012-2013

Overview: This state funded program authorized under Minnesota Statutes 299A.296 was created to enhance the community's sense of personal security and assists communities in crime control and prevention efforts. Funding available for FY2012 was \$1,999,658.

Priority for funding shall be given to:

- Projects serving geographical areas that have the highest crime rate or areas that have the highest concentration of economically disadvantaged youth.
- Projects that demonstrate substantial involvement in planning, implementation, and evaluation by the members of the community served.

COMMUNITY CRIME PREVENTION GRANTS 2012

GRANTEE	PROGRAM DESCRIPTION
AMICUS, Inc	Reconnect is deepening partnerships with other service providers in the South Minneapolis area and maximizing the programs presence in the community by providing services at local halfway houses and other transitional housing facilities.
Beltrami Area Service Collaborative	The Delinquency Intervention Program (DIP) is an offering of the Beltrami Area Service Collaborative that provides prevention and early intervention programming to youth offenders, their families, and the broader Beltrami County community.
Breaking Free	The three programs that are used to increase self-efficiency in lives of women and girls leaving lives of systemic violence are the Life/Job Skills Education Program, Public Policy/Legal Advocacy Program, and the Offender's Prostitution Program (John School).
Dakota Wicohan	The goal of the Tiwahe Program is to reduce the likelihood of violence and gang involvement among 50 American Indian youth and their families in southwestern Minnesota.
Faribault Youth Services Center	The Thrive Mentoring Program occurs during afterschool and summer programming with 75 or more Somali and Latino students in grades 6 through 8 (ages 11 to 15) who are at high-risk of juvenile delinquency and engagement in the criminal justice system.
HIRED	Boys Totem Town Employment Project goal is to enhance community safety in lower-income neighborhoods of St. Paul, and to assist these communities in their crime prevention efforts, particularly as they relate to youth offenses.
Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board	Project Re-Connect is designed to engage and support youth who are at-risk for participating in violence, and a parent or caring adult in their lives - through relationship, community, and skill building activities.
Opportunity Neighborhood Development Corp.	Eden Park Safety Initiative is a community based crime prevention program at Eden Park Apartments, a large affordable housing community in Brooklyn Park.
People Incorporated	People Incorporated and its partner Dakota County probation, courts and schools provides Cognitive Behavioral Therapy skills to youth who are on probation in the county.
St Stephen's Human Services, Inc.	"The Downtown 100" Street Outreach focuses efforts on social interventions, connections and access to human services, and the development of stable housing to homeless individuals.
Tri-County Community Corrections	Tri-County Community Corrections Intensive Supervision Initiative provides intensive supervision, treatment and rehabilitation options to high-risk offenders.
