### Byrne Justice Assistance Grants (JAG) 2018-2020

**Overview:** The U.S. Department of Justice provides JAG fund to prevent and control crime and improve the functioning of the criminal and juvenile justice systems.

The 2017 Minnesota Justice Assistance Grants are providing criminal and juvenile justice interventions for adults and juveniles. The grants fund about the same amount of youth and adult projects. The grants vary in intervention type and include reentry, restorative justice, out of home placement alternatives, intensive case management, chemical and mental health centered programs as well as others.
