



DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS RESIDENTIAL SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT (RSAT) 2015

Overview: The federal Bureau of Justice Assistance allocates this formula block grant to each state. The purpose is to support the development of residential substance abuse treatment programs in corrections settings. A minimum of 10% of the award must be awarded to a jail-based correctional and detention facility. Grantees are required to provide a 25% hard cash or in-kind match.

Program funding criteria stipulate that participants must be:

- serving a minimum sentence of three to six months,
- drug tested regularly, and
- separated from the general population.

The FFY 15 is \$85,116.
