Teddi L. Wind is the mother of Minnesota teen Nevaeh Kingbird who has been missing since Oct. 22, 2021, and who is enrolled with Red Lake Nation.

Teddi is a Leech Lake Band member who seeks to continue to raise awareness about her daughter's case, which remains unsolved, as well as other similar cases that have affected her community.

Teddi is also a student at Leech Lake Tribal College, located in Cass Lake. She is pursuing a degree in law enforcement. Her hope is to influence a systems change to better serve families that have been affected by missing and murdered indigenous relatives (MMIR).

Teddi is a first responder in her community, serving the casino in Cass Lake.

Teddi hopes to help uplift the voices of survivors of MMIR in order to raise awareness and support other families experiencing hardship.

Teddi continues to ask difficult questions to complex issues related to MMIR to advocate for long-term systemic change.
