Grant Opportunity: Southern MN CPS Liaison

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety (DPS), through its Office of Traffic Safety (OTS), is providing a grant opportunity for a Southern Child Passenger Safety Liaison. The Liaison is an experienced child passenger safety instructor and/or technician that will encourage, assist, and foster relationships with law enforcement personnel, public health workers, the general public and other Child Passenger Safety advocates to increase CPS presence and education in the southern half of Minnesota. This position is known as the Southern CPS Liaison.

The Liaison's function is to increase the compliance and correct use of child passenger safety seats. This is accomplished by serving as a link for the OTS to promote participation in child passenger safety programs promoted by the OTS and increase CPS activities in Southern Minnesota. The grant cycle for this year will run from January, 15, 2017 through September 30, 2017. Future oneyear grants may be available from October 1 - September 30, following the federal fiscal year.

MN 2016 TZD Conference – CPS Highlights

The 2016 Toward Zero Deaths Conference was held November 16-17 in Duluth, MN. This was the 13th annual statewide conference for traffic safety stakeholders working towards the goal of zero preventable deaths on Minnesota roads. This conference offers a CPS track, providing CPS professionals an opportunity to garner education and earn CPS CEU's.

The conference kicked-off with the preconference training: Installing Child Safety Restraint Systems on School Buses. Several CPS Techs and Instructors participated in this day-long training.

The general CPS Sessions included the following topics and presenters:

- 1. Fact or Fiction: Dispelling Child Passenger Safety Myths, with Kim Herrmann from Safe Kids Worldwide
- Meet the Manufactures: Highlighted new product features from the following manufacturers: Britax, UPPA Baby, Graco, Recaro, and Evenflo.

- 3. *Meet the Crash Dummies*: Participants learned how test dummies are used when certifying car seats. Speaker: Sarah Tilton, Britax Child Safety Inc.
- Communicating CPS across Cultures: This session explored ways to reach and connect with underserved populations. Presenters: Joel Glaser and Phavanna Nina Scheller with Ampers Diverse Radio for Minnesota's Communities; KaRee Lockling, Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa.
- 5. Why Can't We Just Do This? Offered insight to the scope of car seat development and the manufacturing process. Speaker: Sarah Haverstick, Evenflo Company Inc.

Winter Jackets and Car Seats Dangers

Bulky winter jackets and snowsuits can cause harness straps/seatbelts to be too loose which can limit the effectiveness of a child restraint or seat-belt. Extra slack in a harness can be very dangerous and can result in a child passing through the harness, or becoming ejected from the restraint. As the temperatures drop, many people have concerns about keeping

children safe from the cold AND safe in the car. Here are some recommendations:

- Demonstrate extra harness slack with a bulky jacket compared to lightweight clothing
- Warm up the car before the trip
- Dress in thin, lightweight layers (fleece works great)
- Secure a child in their seat without a coat and place the coat on the child backwards to cover their arms and body
- Place blankets over the child and straps
- Use infant carrier covers that don't interfere with the harness

The Toward Zero Death Child Passenger Safety Star Award is given each year to recognize an individual who demonstrates excellence in child passenger safety. The 2016 CPS Star Award acknowledges Laura Owens, an Administrative Information Specialist with the Duluth Fire Department. Laura has been a CPST since 2002 and a CPSI since 2006. She has trained more than 325 technicians and 120 practitioners, and certified hundreds of daycare and foster care providers. Laura demonstrates her passion for CPS by creating monthly child safety checks and clinics, leading the fire department's annual CPS class, providing multiple child care/foster care classes, and training firefighters with the practitioner program.
