- ❖ Ability to complete ACLS, BTLS, PALS and CPR courses with accompanying Certifications.
- ❖ FEMA ICS 100, 200, 300, 400, 700, and 800.
- ❖ License requirements: a) Valid vehicle operator equivalent to Minnesota Class “D”; b) Ability to obtain Minnesota Class “B” license as necessary;
- ❖ Certification with the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians as a Paramedic and able to be certified as a Paramedic in the State of Minnesota;
