Fires have occurred while e-cigarettes were being used, the battery was being charged, or the device was being transported.

SMOKING SAFETY TIPS

- If you smoke, smoke outside.
- Discard of cigarettes in a deep, sturdy ashtray filled with water or sand.
- Do not discard cigarettes in vegetation like mulch, potted plants, peat moss or leaves.
- Do not smoke while using medical oxygen or near medical oxygen.
- Do not smoke while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
