## Burn Injury Reporting Requirement

**MN Statutes 626.52, Subd. 3 requires the reporting of burn injuries meeting specific criteria to the State Fire Marshal.**

**At this facility, report forms are located:**

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Minnesota Statutes 626.52, Subd 3. **Reporting Burns.** A health professional shall file a written report with the state fire marshal within 72 hours after being notified of a burn injury or wound that the professional is called upon to treat, dress, or bandage, if the victim has sustained second- or third-degree burns to five percent or more of the body, the victim has sustained burns to the upper respiratory tract or sustained laryngeal edema from inhaling superheated air, or the victim has sustain a burn injury or wound that may result in the victim's death. The state fire marshal shall provide the form for the report.
