### **NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF RULES PROPOSED FOR ADOPTION WITHOUT A PUBLIC HEARING TO THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS**

**Amendment to Rules Governing Part-time Peace Officer Licensing and Examination, Minnesota Rules, 6700.0600 Subpart 2, 6700.1000 Subparts 1, 3, 7, and 9 and 6700.1101 subparts 2, 3, 4, and 7; Revisor's ID Number R-4341**

TO: ALL INTERESTED PERSONS

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision 2, this notice is being sent to all persons who have registered their name with the agency under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.14, subdivision 1a. This notice is also posted on the website of the Minnesota Board of Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST Board).

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the above-captioned rules proposed for adoption will be submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings on the date of this notice, October 2, 2015. A copy of the rule changes is attached to this notice.

By Laws of Minnesota 2014, chapter 244, section 1, subdivision 1, the Minnesota Legislature requires the executive director of the POST Board to make the following rule changes:

The Peace Officer Standards and Training Board shall amend Minnesota Rules, parts 6700.0600, subpart 2; 6700.1000, subparts 1, 2, 7, and 9; and 6700.1101, subpart 2, so that new part-time peace officer licenses are not issued and that existing licenses are canceled when a part-time license holder either leaves the officer's agency of employment or is not employed by a law enforcement agency on or after June 30, 2014. The board may invoke the good cause exemption to the rulemaking procedures in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14, as provided for in Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision 1, clause (3), to implement the conforming amendments listed in this section.

The POST Board is using the good cause exemption process under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subd. 1, clause (3), to make the specific changes set forth in the above-referenced laws without additional interpretation.
