1.3 **6700.0600 LICENSING EXAMINATIONS.**

1.5 Subp. 2. **Nonrefundable fee.** A nonrefundable fee shall be paid to the board before
1.6 taking the following licensing examinations:

1.7 A. peace officer licensing examination, \$105; and

1.8 B. reciprocity examination, \$105; and.

1.9 C. ~~part-time peace officer licensing examination, \$52.50.~~

1.11 **6700.1000 LICENSE RENEWAL.**

1.12 Subpart 1. **Validity of licenses and renewal dates.** Peace officer licenses issued by
1.13 the board under part 6700.0800 are valid until they expire, are revoked, or are surrendered
1.14 by the licensee. Part-time peace officer licenses issued by the board pursuant to part
1.15 6700.1101 are valid until they expire, are revoked, or are surrendered by the licensee.

1.16 ~~The licenses of licensees whose surnames begin with the letters A through G are due
1.17 for renewal on July 1, 1983, and on July 1 every third year thereafter.~~

1.18 ~~The licenses of licensees whose surnames begin with the letters H through M are due
1.19 for renewal on July 1, 1984, and on July 1 every third year thereafter.~~

1.20 ~~The licenses of licensees whose surnames begin with the letters N through Z are due
1.21 for renewal on July 1, 1982, and on July 1 every third year thereafter.~~

1.23 Subp. 3. **Certificate of renewal.** The executive director shall issue a certificate
1.24 of renewal, which is valid for three years, to each applicant who has submitted the

2.1 appropriate fee on or before June 30 of the year when the license becomes due for
 2.2 renewal and also completed the ~~required~~ 48 hours of ~~required~~ continuing education. The
 2.3 appropriate fees are \$90 for renewal of a peace officer license and \$45 for renewal of a
 2.4 part-time peace officer license. ~~The required hours of continuing education are:~~

2.5 ~~A. 16 hours for a peace officer or a part-time peace officer who has been~~
 2.6 ~~licensed for at least six months but less than 18 months;~~

2.7 ~~B. 32 hours for a peace officer or a part-time peace officer who has been~~
 2.8 ~~licensed for at least 18 months but less than 30 months; and~~

2.9 ~~C. 48 hours for a peace officer or a part-time peace officer who has been~~
 2.10 ~~licensed for at least 30 months.~~

2.12 Subp. 7. **License renewal fee.** For the purposes of subparts 6 and 9, the appropriate
 2.13 license renewal fee for an ~~expired license is as follows:~~

2.14 ~~A. expired peace officer license is \$125; or~~

2.15 ~~B. expired part-time peace officer license is \$80.~~

2.17 Subp. 9. **Licensing examination.** For the purposes of subpart 8, the appropriate
 2.18 licensing examination is ~~as follows:~~

2.19 ~~A. the peace officer licensing examination for a peace officer; or~~

2.20 ~~B. the part-time peace officer licensing examination for a part-time peace officer.~~

3.2 Subp. 3. **Documentation.** The chief law enforcement officer shall maintain the
3.3 documentation necessary to show compliance with Minnesota Rules 2014, part 6700.1101,
3.4 subpart 2, items A to D. The documentation is subject to periodic review by the board
3.5 and shall be made available to the board upon its request.

3.8 Subp. 7. ~~Inactive status~~ **Notice of termination of part-time peace officer license.**

3.9 The chief law enforcement officer shall notify the board within ten days of all voluntary or
3.10 involuntary terminations of part-time peace officers. The notification shall include the
3.11 name of licensee, licensee's forwarding address, unless the licensee requests that this
3.12 information not be divulged, and date of termination. ~~An individual who possesses an~~
3.13 ~~inactive part-time peace officer license has no part-time peace officer power or authority.~~

3.14 ~~An individual possessing a part-time peace officer license may maintain the license in~~
3.15 ~~inactive status provided that he or she meets the requirements of part 6700.1000, subpart 3.~~

3.16 ~~An individual who is appointed to the position of a part-time peace officer within~~
3.17 ~~three years of the date when the individual's license was placed on inactive status is not~~
3.18 ~~required to comply with selection standards outlined in subpart 2, items A to C.~~

3.19 ~~An individual who is appointed as a part-time peace officer more than three years~~
3.20 ~~after the date the individual's license was placed on an inactive status is required to~~
3.21 ~~complete the selection standards outlined in subpart 2, items A to C, prior to his or her first~~
3.22 ~~day of employment. For compliance with this subpart, previously completed standards~~
3.23 ~~are not acceptable. The chief law enforcement officer shall maintain the documentation~~
3.24 ~~necessary to show compliance with this subpart. The documentation is subject to periodic~~
3.25 ~~review by the board and shall be made available upon request by the board.~~
