Minnesota Statute 626.87 requires a thorough background investigation on ALL applicants for a Peace Officer position. A thorough Background Investigation shall include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Documentation of compliance with Minimum Selection Standards*.
- Current copies of state and federal criminal history inquiries.
- Documentation of local law enforcement records (including juvenile contacts if applicable) for residential communities and counties during the previous ten years.
- An interview of the candidate's previous or current employer(s) to include coworkers, and/or an interview of the candidate's Law Enforcement Program Coordinator if applicable.
- An interview of the candidate's current/recent classmates if applicable, and/or neighbors.

*If the candidate is currently employed as a Peace Officer, or was employed as a Peace Officer within the last three years, the agency **may**, at its discretion, affirm that the applicant has already completed some of the selection standards, but documentation of successful completion of these standards must be maintained by the agency.

NOTE: If the candidate was last employed as a Peace Officer more than three years ago, **ALL** minimum selection standards must be complied with and the name of the Licensed Psychologist and the recommendation must be entered above.
