# Notification of Conviction in Another State or Jurisdiction by Commercial Driver

## Print and mail this completed form to:

- Under Minn. Stat. § 171.168, the holder of a Minnesota Commercial Driver's License (CDL) shall notify the Department of Public Safety within 30 days upon conviction of:
  - Any criminal offense
  - A serious traffic violation as defined in 49 C.F.R. § 383.51
  - Violating any other state or local law relating to a motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation) in any type of motor vehicle in another state or jurisdiction.
