

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS COMMUNITY & YOUTH CRIME PREVENTION GRANTS 2022

Overview: This state funded program authorized under Minnesota Statutes 299A.296 was created to enhance the community's sense of personal security and assists communities in crime control and prevention efforts.

Priority for funding shall be given to:

- Projects serving geographical areas that have the highest crime rate or areas that have the highest concentration of economically disadvantaged youth.
- Projects that demonstrate substantial involvement in planning, implementation, and evaluation by the members of the community served.

Asian Media Access	Project TECH (Technology for Employment, Communication and Health) Supporting Youth from families with inter-generational poverty to reduce/prevent crimes.
Beltrami Area Service Collaborative	Prevention and Intervention Youth Services project provides case management for truant students, Peace Circles, and an attendance campaign.
Cass County Probation	Cass County Pretrial program is a collaborative effort among Cass County, Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe and our communities.

EMERGE Community Development	North 4 Project's goal is to reduce crime and violence by creating pathways to success for justice-involved/at-risk young men.
HIRED	HIRED's Restoring Hope Program will foster positive transitions to adulthood with young people at risk of recidivism.
Isuroon	Somali Youth Thrive Program engages Somali youth, families and religious leaders to create a safe community.
Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota	LSS Duluth Truancy Action Project (TAP) provides intensive services to assist at-risk students to remove barriers to school attendance.
Men As Peacemakers	Don't Buy It Project is a Sex trafficking prevention project via statewide trainings for Safe Harbor grantees.
SOAR Career Solutions	Provides transition support to individuals returning back to the Duluth area from incarceration.
Ujamaa Place	Ujamaa Place Serves young African American men with barriers, aiming to create productive members of society.
YWCA Of Minneapolis	Girls Resolution and Prevention (RAP) provides intervention services to girls at-risk/involved with the juvenile justice system.
