



Did you know?

Incendiary describes any fire that is intentionally set. An arson fire is an example of an incendiary fire but not all incendiary fires are arson.

Over the last five years there was an average of 904 incendiary fires in Minnesota.

The most common place for incendiary fires is residential structures.

ARSON PREVENTION

- Remove overgrown vegetation, brush and trash from your property.
- Pay attention to vehicles in disrepair on your property. Car fires can spread quickly.
- Continue to evaluate the space around your home and consider removing items that may burn.
- Get to know your neighbors and help each other keep an eye on the neighborhood.
